Concert Attire Dos and Don'ts

Students performing at concerts shall wear one of the following:

- either an all-black floor-length concert dress with wide straps, a modest neckline, and no slits
- or a black tuxedo or black suit (NO charcoal, navy blue or pinstripes) with a white tuxedo shirt or white collared dress shirt and black bow tie
 - girls who choose to wear black suits may wear a black blouse instead of a white dress shirt

DO wear a concert dress with:



- solid black color
- Ø floor-length

- Shoes all black, keep heel height to a minimum, open-toed ok

DON'T wear*:



- 8 halter neck
- **⊗** low-cut neckline
- **⊗** slits



- Strapless
- 8 bare back



- 😢 spaghetti straps
- 8 bare back
- 8 midi instead of floor-length
- Shoes not solid black



- **⊗**jump suit
- Shoes not solid black

*An all-black cardigan/jacket may be worn to cover up features of dresses not allowed such as strapless, halter neck, low-cut neckline, spaghetti straps or bare back

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DO wear a tuxedo with:



- Solid black color
- Solid white dress shirt, tucked in
- Solid black cumberband (optional)
- Solid black bow tie
- Solid black dress socks
- Solid black dress shoes

DO wear a suit with:



- Solid black color
- Solid white collared shirt, tucked in
- Solid black bow tie
- Solid black dress socks
- Solid black dress shoes

DO wear a pant suit with:



- Solid black color
- solid black blouse, tucked in
- Shoes all black, keep heel height to a minimum, open-toed ok

DON'T wear*:



- casual shirt
- untucked shirt
- 8 no bow tie
- casual shoes
